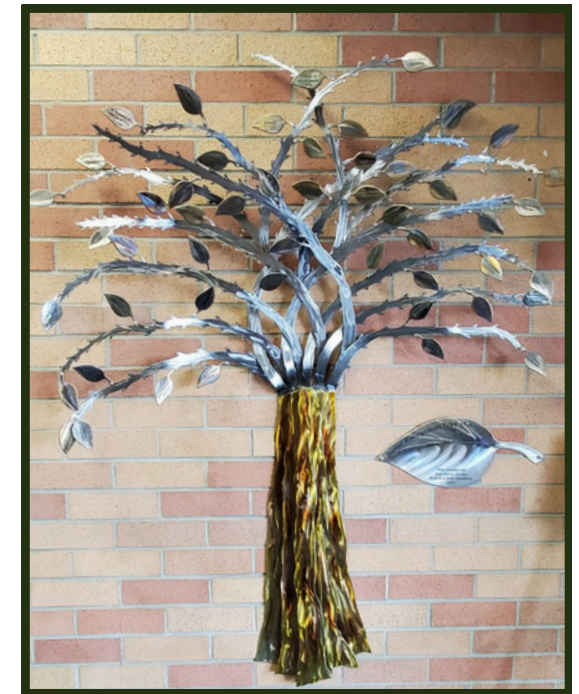

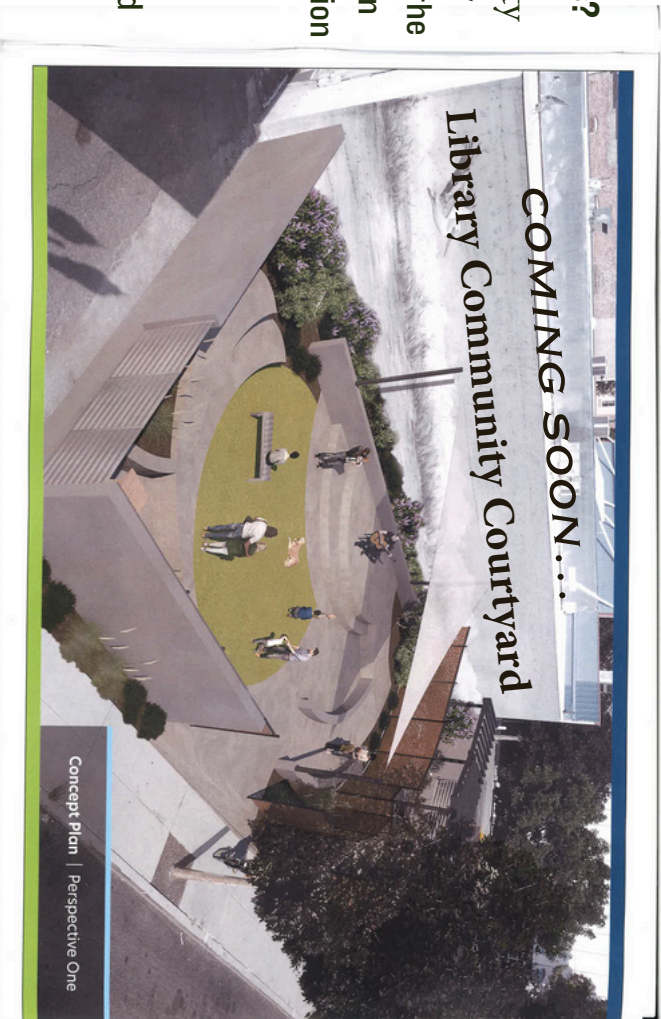
Projects funded by Klamath County Library Foundation since 2004:
